EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN FOR MUTUAL16

Basic Preparations for an emergency

- Check your smoke alarm(s) at least once a year
- Prepare a disaster supply kit that contains essential food, water, and supplies for at least three days. Consider having supplies for sheltering in place for at least two weeks as well as a battery operated radio, a corded telephone and one or more working flashlights.
- Keep informed: Listen to WTOP and other local television and radio broadcasts regarding weather emergencies.

In case of **FIRE**:

- Leave your unit at the first sign of fire. Grab your cell phone or cordless phone on the way out. **Do not** try to fight the fire.
- Immediately call 911.
- Alert your neighbors attached to your unit.
- **Follow the instructions** of the Emergency Responders.

In case of **HURRICANE**:

 Stay in your unit away from windows until the storm is over.

 Listen for local instructions on TV, radio or other devices regarding local conditions before leaving your unit after the storm.

In case of a **TORNADO**:

Stay in your unit.

• **Do not** open the windows.

• Take cover in an interior room without windows.
