



NEW MEDICARE CARDS - NEW SCAM - IMPORTANT

Medicare Cards without Social Security Numbers Coming in 2018 Office of the Inspector General, SSA

Here's what you need to know to protect yourself, family and friends throughout the US.

Starting 4/1/18 Medicare will start a year long, project to replace all current Medicare cards for beneficiaries to convert to alphanumeric ID numbers. Currently the ID number is your social security number. This is starting to hit the media.

Scammers are opportunistic! First of all, the new Medicare card will come to you in the mail...

You don't need to request it or do anything. It will show up.

WHAT'S THE SCAM?

"Somebody from "MEDICARE" will call to tell you are getting a new Medicare card. But until it comes you will need a temporary card. Fee for the card is between \$5-50 dollars." They want personal information, bank account or credit card so they can process your temporary card.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Medicare will never call you unless you ask them to.

Medicare does all communications by mail unless you ask them to call.

Ditto for anybody saying they "work with Medicare to make sure you get everything you are entitled to." Scammer alert.

First of all, spread the word.

Feel free to share these notes.

Use your answering machine to screen calls or just don't even answer a number you don't recognize.

If it has happened to you or your friends or loved ones and personal info had been given out (happens considerably more often than you think so don't feel bad or stupid) immediately take action to protect yourself against identity theft.

NOMOROBO TO THE RESCUE!

<u>Junk call blocking</u> that works with Comcast, Verizon, and others is <u>NOMOROBO.COM</u>. It is easy to sign up, and free for landlines. Works for 80% of junk calls. The phone rings once in your house and then is checked for the source. If it is a junk caller the phone will stop ringing. If others, the phone just rings normally. It does not block personal calls, family, doctor offices, or political calls. There is no charge. You can also get it for mobile phone, however there is a charge for that.

NOMOROBO.COM. was developed at the request of the FCC and it has been lauded by Consumer Reports and other review groups.

SPRING TIME WARNING - RACOONS!!!!

It really is spring time, even though the weather doesn't seem to enforce that idea, it will indeed begin to get warmer – BUT – even though the weather does not seem totally spring-like, the many springtime activities of the local wildlife are in full bloom. This especially results in a number of local denizens (Racoons, for instance) looking for protected habitats for their newly born offspring, and where better to find such a habitat in the large number of residents with unoccupied attics that are occasionally easy for them to get into by creating openings in areas like around air vents and at roof joints, and under the roof overhangs. Really, anyplace that has a joint or separation in the structural surface.

Racoons, in particular, are quite strong and have very useable hands that allow them to take advantage of the slightest opening in the structure.

AND THEY DO!!! As several incidents in the past few years attest. They have been found in at least three attics in the past couple of years, probably, as a result of the extensive construction across Norbeck Road that has undoubtedly destroyed much of their natural habitat, and forced them to seek new, protected areas to raise a family.

It is very important that you be aware of their presence and to notify us as soon as possible if they should select your residence. In addition to the damage they cause getting into your attic, they can cause considerable damage to the environment in your attic once they do get inside. The insulation is torn apart and greatly soiled, the walls and ceiling boards can also be damaged beyond repair and will require extensive replacement.

Your Mutual Management has several companies who can help you take care of the problem if it gets started in your residence and will be happy to facilitate contact with those who have the most reasonable cost for your problem. Unfortunately, animal infestation problems are not covered by the Mutual and are usually not covered by your homeowners insurance. So be aware and be vigilant!
