In addition, turn off the breaker switch to the water heater at the main panel to prevent a possible fire caused by electricity feeding a heater element surrounded by water if the tank has leaked (our homes are built on slabs without a central drain).
- Turn off the water valve at the clothes washer. Washer hoses can spring leaks. (This is a good thing to do after each washer load- it takes the stress off the hose)
- Make sure to tell your neighbors that you are leaving and supply them with emergency contact information.
